

A New Vision for Richmond Methodist Church



You are invited to a Consultation about the new vision for the Richmond Methodist Church Buildings. Based on our Vision Statement we plan to upgrade our facilities to enhance our place of worship, to provide a welcoming, modern space for our many current users, and to be able to extend that offer to others. We propose to create a flexible, multi-purpose, carbon neutral special place, fit for the 21st Century which we intend to be an asset to our town. We are aware that our building lies within the conservation area, and we want our new facilities to reflect this, while making a new and creative statement. This consultation will be in two parts.

Firstly, for the church Congregation and members of the North Yorkshire Dales Methodist Circuit at 12.00 midday on Sunday 27th April 2025 at the Church. (after the circuit service.)

Secondly, for all current and prospective users of the building, as well as all members of the community who are interested in what we plan. This will also be at the church on Monday 19th May 2025 at 7.00pm

Both occasions will include presentations by the Church Vision Group, and Jenny Harrison of the Architects Grid and Grain. There will be 3D and pictorial and graphic representations. In particular, there will be an opportunity to ask questions and discuss the project. Feedback may also be sent via QR codes or hard copy forms in the building. This is part of wider consultation program to enable us to provide a building which enhances the current and future community provision in the town and serves the needs of all users.
